Scope

StCatsHacks 2023 is the sixth edition of the inter-school hackathon held in Greece. Computer Science lower-school and high-school students will convene at St. Catherine's British School for two days hack programming competition. In teams of 4/5, with access to APIs and the guidance of dedicated mentors, students are called to create innovative computer programs which will be evaluated on their functionality and applicability in the real world. This year's theme is the UN 14 Development Goals. Participants are encouraged to develop solutions that tackle various challenges, including marine pollution, overfishing, friendly shipping, climate change impacts, sustainable aquaculture, ocean conservation, and more, but any idea of your own could be apt. Food will be available for all participants and winners will be receiving awesome prizes. We look forward to seeing you all on December 2nd.
